Creation of Project (10 points)	0-4 points Student did not finish hard slab project, but did begin one.	5-9 points Student turned in one complete hard slab project.	10 points Student turned in more than one complete project.		
Creative Design (25 points)	0-12 points There is no obvious design to the project Or the design was not well thought out and sloppy.	13-19 points Attempt was made to use a design care was not taken in paying attention to details.	20-25 points The design was made with great care and attention to detail. Evidence in obvious decision making and planning.		
Construction (20 points)	0-9 points The student had to start over due to poor technique or student did not use hard slab construction techniques.	10-17 points The hard slab project is functional for its purpose and shows knowledge of hard slab construction. Some sharp edges are still apparent, but effort was put in to smooth all edges and seams. Some planning was evident.	18-20 points The project was constructed very well with all edges smooth and no blemishes. Thought and planning was put into the piece. The project shows more creative thought and is not a simple plain shape.		
Glaze Application (20 Points)	0-9 points The project was not glazed OR the glaze application did not demonstrate good technique: application was messy and/or glaze was on the bottom of the project.	10-17 points The project was glazed, but glaze choice seems random and doesn't emphasize the design. More than one glaze was applied or an advanced technique was tried, but not successful.	18-20 points CLEAR decision-making is evident in the selection of the glaze used. Either the glaze used enhances the design or an advanced glazing technique was used successfully.		
Studio Habits (20 points)	0-9 points The student had to start over several times due to improperly stored project, excessive absences, or wasted studio time. Little effort.	10-17 points With construction issues student made some attempt to correct the problem, but not full effort for the best outcome. If they had absences they did not come in outside of class to catch up, but they did work super hard when they were in class.	18-20 points This student worked tirelessly, solving problems as they came up in order to have successful project. In class consistently and used their time well. If they had absences they came in outside of class to make up the time.		
Glazing Sheet (5 points)	0 points No glazing sheet was completed for the project.	1-4 points A glazing sheet was partially filled out OR it was filled out AFTER the project came out of the glaze fire.	5 points All parts of the glazing sheet have been filled out including the types of glazes used, the method and technique, the result and whether it was successful.
